2024 Dairy Margin Coverage sign-up is open, enrollment for DMC is now – April 29th, 2024. For those who sign up for 2024 DMC coverage, payments may begin as soon as March 4th, 2024 for any payments that triggered in January 2024. The DMC program is an important safety net program offered through the US Department of Agriculture that provides producers with price support to help offset milk and feed prices differences. Please contact your local FSA office for more information and to get signed up. You can also find more information on this year's program along with revised coverage for 2024 and other risk management tools for dairy producers.
