Stay prepared to help your cattle battle the heat with many of our products through Purina, Hubbard, Vita Plus, FAF, etc... This will help keep your cattle hydrated and the feed fresh for the cattle. We are still offering \$2/bag off Hydro-lac when you purchase 40 or more. We also have many inoculant options for making your forages this summer, to give you higher quality and fresh feeds coming out of those silos and bags for the cattle and to help save you money by not buying as much protein for the cattle. Make sure your cattle waterers are cleaned out to give your cattle good clean water and help them out with the heat. The grain and soybean meal markets continue to amaze me on how they move 20-40 cents or \$10-15/ton each day now days but if you are interested in locking in any grain or feed please let us know. We are still offering future contracting on Soybean meal, Canola, Amino Plus, and Corn Gluten Pellets. Now through September is the time to watch the prices most years and do any contracting and those that did last fall are saving up to \$200/ton on most of their contracts. I'm not saying that will happen again but just sharing what you could save.
