If you are still interested in locking in any commodities for Dec24-Sept25 or any combination of months please let me know. If you have annually locked prices in the past, I'd still recommend taking a look at the current prices and if you never have done this before and are interested, please reach out with any questions. We will continue to do our best to find the best quality and prices on products we can, to provide to our patrons. I will continue to run the commodity contract prices daily or weekly and if you want updates of these prices Email me @ jason@sunriseagcoop.com and I'll add you to the list or let any of your nutritionists know and they can let me know to add you as well. If you are interested in locking in any grain or feed, please let us know. We are offering future contracting on Soybean meal, Canola, Amino Plus, Soy Hull Pellets, NovaMeal, and Corn Gluten Pellets (direct to the farm only). You can use our website to order feed, check out the local cash bids for grain selling, and we have the local DTN news, weather, and markets as well.
