This barely covers the rise in the costs of everything that goes into our freight situation and we are just trying to stay even with what we were at before the rise of all these costs. Lyle Landowski from Hubbard feeds retired last month. Everyone at Sunrise would like to thank Lyle for his years of service he provided for the Sunrise Ag patrons through Hubbard feeds. Hubbard is in the process of replacing Lyle and have hired Wyatt Lawrence. Wyatt is from the Princeton area and his cell number is 320-391-1430, he will be introducing himself out in the country very soon after he is through his training. Feed and grain markets continue to be a roller coaster each day but have been holding pretty steady now in that \$8/bu range Chicago market wise. We are still offering future contracting on Soybean meal, Canola, Amino Plus, and Corn Gluten Pellets. Now is probably not the time to do any contracting but those that did last fall are saving up to \$150/ton on most of their contracts.
