Feed/Grain news – With the new Coronavirus going on in China and around the world currently we are experiencing some up ticks in prices with anything that has vitamins involved in it so if you see some price increases in mineral/vitamin packs that is why! Please continue to make sure you are checking your grain bins and please be safe and have a 2nd person with you if you choose to go inside of your bin. There has still been a lot of talk from patrons at the Coop saying there bins have been getting warm. This year with the quality of the grain, fines have been more of an issue with bins heating up than the moisture. Higher moistures will create this issue but patrons have been mentioning that even at lower moistures like 13-14% they still had some warm spots simply due to fines in the bins. Please make sure you run your fans and maybe move those centers before it's too late! We are having spring booking discounts on Purina and Hubbard minerals and tubs so please talk to Jos, Kathy, Ron, Lyle, or call any of our stores and they will help you out. Another issue we may have going into spring is Corn silage made when it was frozen becoming moldy or bad when the spring warmth thaws it out, please keep an eye on this along with communicating with your nutritionists. We are still pretty competitive on our grain prices, so if you are thinking of selling grain keep an eye on our website! We are always offering future contracting on Soybean meal, Canola, Amino Plus, and Corn Gluten Pellets. You can order feed on there, check out the local cash bids for grain selling, and we have the local DTN news, weather, and markets as well.
